



## Mission of the Month – February

ABC - A Baby Center is the Mission of the Month for February. The mission of the Center is to help families with infants and toddlers up to the age of four who live on Cape Cod and the Islands. Every 30 days, families who meet income guidelines can receive, at no charge, critical basic items. These include diapers, wipes, formula, ointments, baby wash, gently used clothing, baby gear, strollers, high chairs, bouncy seats, blankets, and bath tubs. In addition to these items, the Center provides parenting support programs, nutritional guidance, private consultations, an on-site visiting nurse, and resource information. The primary address of the Baby Center is on Willow Avenue in Hyannis but they also have locations in Mashpee and Chatham. In addition to financial donations this month we will also be collecting some of the items on the Center's wish list. You can see the wish list on the Baby Center's web site or on the Missions bulletin board in the Narthex. More specifics about items to be collected here in the church will be in the Sunday bulletins during the month of February. Many families on the Cape struggle to afford diapers and other products they need to ensure good health and safety for their children. Just having clean diapers can make a huge difference for a child. The Baby Center is a program of the Council of Churches whose mission is "serving God by serving others". We are privileged to be a part of this loving effort.




#### **SOUP R BOWL SUNDAY**
